REFEREE DEPOSIT REFUND PROCEDURE

1. In order to receive your team referee deposit, you must fulfill the following requirements.
 - a. Supply a **qualified referee “team”** per game played.
 - b. Referees **must sign in** before each game at the referee assignment table.
 - c. Each referee must identify themselves as well as the region and team they represent. A picture ID may be required.
 - d. Each referee team must referee **ALL SCHEDULED** games with a complete 3 person team.
 - e. Referees are requested to make themselves available for playoff games on Sunday afternoon.
2. If these requirements are not met, the referee refund may be partially or wholly forfeited.
3. Refunds will be issued to the participating teams region within ten (10) working days of the end of the tournament.

REFEREE PLAN

A. All Referees must be AYSO/Safe Haven Certified and trained and must be able to referee in the division of the team that they are representing at a minimum (e.g U-10/U-12 Regional Referees, U-14 at least 1 intermediate/2 Regional referees, and U-16/19 at least 1 advanced or National referee, and 2 intermediate referees) Referees will be expected to uphold the tournament rules, AYSO guidelines and FIFA laws. Any willful failure of the referee to uphold these rules may be cause for dismissal from the tournament, and will place a team's referee deposit refund in jeopardy.

B. Only the diagonal system of control will be used.

C. Referees will be expected to fill out the game cards and to keep track of substitutions (U-10-u-14). Referees will assure that tournament time monitoring sheets are completed and submitted for all U16 and U19 matches.

D. Referees will be expected to note on the back of the game cards and to fill out misconduct reports immediately following a game in which a misconduct (caution and/or send-off) was issued to a player or coach, or if there were spectator interference problems, or any other action that merits a report.

E. Referees will be expected to turn in all completed game cards and misconduct reports to the Referee Tent immediately following each game refereed.

F. Additional referees will be provided by Region 66 and from the surrounding regions and Areas to ensure all games are covered by qualified referees. These referees will be provided assignments on a stand-by or fill-in basis. Priority will be given to referee crews to ensure an opportunity to earn their deposit refund.

G. Every Referee is expected to check in at the Referee Tent at least 30 minutes prior to their assigned game at which time your referee card (provided by tournament) will be stamped. Failure to appear on time may result in a replacement referee crew being assigned to the field. Once a replacement crew has been assigned, they will have priority and the original crew must report to the Referee station for alternative assignment, or risk forfeiting referee deposit. Upon completing your third and final assignment, you are to turn in your referee card to receive gifts and get full credit for games refereed. **This must be done by each individual referee.**

H. Referees will be provided with a meal ticket for food and drink at the concession stand for each day that they officiate. Chilled water and snacks will also be available at the Referee Station.
